Towing Efficiency

Every Airstream travel trailer features an aerodynamic profile that improves towing fuel efficiency and handling. But our single-axle trailers are especially nimble and can be easily towed by mid-sized trucks and SUVs.

Low Center of Gravity

Like all our travel trailers, the holding tanks in our single-axle trailers are built into the chassis – putting more than half the total weight of the trailer below the floor line – resulting in a lower stance and improved stability while towing.

Space Efficiency

Our smaller trailers offer all the comforts you find in larger trailers, with space-efficient floor plans that maximize storage. They’re particularly great for weekend excursions but can handle longer trips too. And all but the Basecamp 16X offer secondary sleeping areas so you can bring along the family.

Modern Conveniences

When you choose a single-axle Airstream, you don’t have to compromise on creature comforts. All models come with thoughtfully designed domestic systems and offer optional upgrades so you can configure your rig to match your style of adventure.

Bambi Key Points

Smart Layouts with Distinct Style

Bambi and Caravel share three identical floor plans in 16, 20, and 22 feet, with major differences in décor, materials, surfaces, finishes, and exterior features. Bambi models all feature panoramic windows up front that wrap around the dinette in the 16-foot model, and spacious beds in the two larger floor plans.

Bathrooms Configurations

Note the differences in bathrooms: An efficient wet bath (16RB), a two-piece corner bath (20FB), or a wide bathroom across the rear of the trailer (22FB).

Galley and Convertible Spaces

Each model has a convertible dinette for extra sleeping space, but the two larger trailers locate that space in the midship. Galley sinks expand to double well in larger models and the 20-foot Bambi has the most counter space, making it ideal for mobile chefs.

Caravel Key Points

Premium Design and Features

While Caravel shares three identical floor plans with Bambi, this upscale model line takes modern style and premium materials to the next level. Though the layouts are the same, surfaces, fixtures, window blinds, upholstery, and many exterior features are different. Caravel was designed for both short excursions and longer trips, with larger cabinets, rear bumper storage, and “Nev-R-Lube” bearings.

Panoramic Views

The Bambi 16RB and Caravel 16RB both have panoramic windows surrounding the front dinette, but in Caravel the rear also features a panoramic window (where Bambi’s is a single rectangular window) for gorgeous views upon waking.

Versatile Floor Plans

Basecamp offers three different models to choose from: Basecamp 16X, Basecamp 20X, and Basecamp 20Xe. Floor plans are shared across 20-foot models, with a galley in the midship across from the wet bath.

Flexible Living and Storage

Basecamp 20-foot models are built for versatility. With two convertible areas, you can customize your setup for dining, lounging, working, or sleeping. Many owners choose to sleep in the rear and use the front dinette for meals and productivity. The swiveling tabletop makes it easy to move in and out without disturbing others, and added storage near the wet bath keeps essentials organized and accessible.

Adventure Ready Features

In Model Year 2026, the previously optional X-Package became a standard feature on 16- and 20-foot Basecamps. Featuring stainless steel front stone guards and front solar guards, a 3-inch lift for navigating challenging terrain, rugged tires, and more, the X-Package enables you to go farther and stay longer. The X-Package also comes standard in Basecamp Xe.

Basecamp 20Xe features two décor packages with style drawn from nature. Sandstone Canyon features warm desert hues while Granite Ridge is anchored by cool, rocky gray.
